**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SEAL PURSUANT TO FLORIDA RULE OF
JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION 2.051**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the motion of the Court Appointed Attorney Guardian Ad Litem pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.05 14 for an order sealing the following information relative to this case:

The Report of the Attorney Guardian Ad Litem

The Court GRANTS the motion as follows:

1. Confidentiality of the Report of the Attorney Guardian Ad Litem is required to protect the interest of the minor children subject to this cause of action.
2. The following persons may have access to this information:
 - The Father and his counsel
 - The Mother and her counsel
 - The Court
 - The Attorney Guardian Ad Litem
 - Expert Witnesses in this action
 - Any other person designated by the court
 - By further order of the court
3. The Court further finds that no less restrictive measure is available to protect this/these interest, and that the degree, duration and manner of confidentiality ordered herein are no broader than necessary to protect the interest.

Wherefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

The Clerk of the Circuit Court is hereby directed to seal immediately the Report of the Attorney Guardian Ad Litem and its attachments and to keep such materials from public access.

It is further **ORDERED** that any material sealed pursuant to this Order shall be conditionally disclosed upon the entry of a further order by this Court finding that such opening is necessary for the purposes of judicial or governmental accountability or First Amendment rights.

It is further **ORDERED** that any material sealed pursuant to this Order may otherwise be disclosed as described above.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby directed to post a copy of the attached Notice of Entry of Order Authorizing sealing on the Clerks and Courts websites for a period of (15) days and to fix a copy of the Order on the outside of the court record.

It is further **ORDERED** that the Clerk is hereby authorized to unseal any material sealed pursuant to this Order for the purpose of filing, microfilming or imaging files, or transmitting a record to an appellate tribunal. The material shall be re-sealed immediately upon completion of the filing.
