2. This Order is being entered in a dissolution of marriage action.


3. The Court finds the above portions of the case file should be confidential and sealed in order to avoid substantial injury to innocent third parties.

4. The Court finds the designated docket entries on the progress docket and similar records generated to document activity in the case are confidential in order to avoid substantial injury to innocent third parties.

5. The only persons authorized to view the confidential information are the Petitioner/Husband and the minor child, upon attaining majority, as they see fit.

6. The Court finds that the decree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the Court are no broader than necessary to protect the interests of innocent third parties, and no less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests of innocent third parties.
