**BY ORDER OF THE COURT:**

Appellants' motion filed on October 17, 2017, is granted only insofar as it seeks to determine confidentiality of the motion to relinquish jurisdiction to the trial court. The motion to relinquish jurisdiction to the trial court and the motion for sanctions filed in the trial court shall remain under seal in this court.

Pursuant to Florida Rule of Judicial Procedure 2.420, this court has determined that:

(A) This is an appeal from a final judgment;

(B) Certain information is determined to be confidential under rule 2.420(c)(7) and sections 44.405-406, Florida Statutes;

(C) No party's name is determined to be confidential;

(D) Neither the progress docket nor similar records generated to document activity in the case are determined to be confidential;

(E) The motion to relinquish jurisdiction to the trial court filed in this court on October 17, 2017, and the motion for sanctions filed in the trial court are determined to be confidential;

(F) The parties and their counsel are permitted to view the confidential information;

(G) The court finds that: (i) The degree, duration, and manner of confidentiality ordered by the court are not broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c); and (ii) No less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in subdivision (c), and

(H) The clerk of the court is directed to publish this order in accordance with subdivision (e)(4).

The appellants' motion to relinquish jurisdiction filed on October 17, 2017, is denied.
