



2010 Tax Amnesty Agreement Effective July 1 to September 30, 2010

Per Resolution 2010-117 approved by the Escambia County Board of County Commissioners on July 8, 2010, eligible businesses and individuals may pay taxes and interest owed to Escambia County without penalty and at discounted interest under a Tax Amnesty Program that is in effect from July 1 through September 30, 2010. The amnesty program applies to the Tourist Development Taxes (TDT) administered by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). It is available for eligible taxpayers who owe taxes that were due on or before June 30, 2010.

If you wish to participate in the amnesty program you must submit a Tax Amnesty Agreement.

To be eligible to participate in the amnesty program, I (the taxpayer) affirm and agree that:

- I give up my right to contest the tax and interest I report under amnesty.
- I withdraw any pending protest or proceeding about the tax and interest I report under amnesty and understand that any protest or proceeding cannot be re-filed.
- I have not previously entered into a settlement of liability with the County for any County tax or local option tax that I report under amnesty.
- I give up my right to claim a refund of tax or interest I pay under amnesty and my right to protest the County's denial of any claim I make for a refund of tax or interest I pay under amnesty.
- Any credit or refund of tax or interest I pay under amnesty is limited to amounts paid in error, as determined by the County.
- I have not been convicted of a crime involving a revenue law of this state.
- I understand that the County may reconsider any amnesty given me if I misrepresent my eligibility to participate or I file false or fraudulent returns and forms under amnesty.

Filing and Paying Taxes under the Tax Amnesty Program

Escambia County encourages taxpayers who are filing Tourist Development Taxes to file returns and make payments to the Clerk of the Circuit Court and Comptroller.
